Various groups and activities are on offer, free of charge, as well as representatives from our partners and various services. Come along and say hello. We are open daily from 9am to 4.30pm, and you do not always need an appointment (closed on Bank Holidays)

Tuesdays

Anna from the Relocation, Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Team will be attending the Family Hub on Tuesday 2nd, 9th, 16th, 23rd, and 30th June - between 9am and 1pm. Anna is able to support parents/carers who have relocated to England from another country and are struggling with barriers to accessing support for their children with SEN or social, emotional and mental health needs.

Emma from Department of Work and Pensions will be available on Tuesdays 10am to 2.30pm and can support with:

- Benefit related queries
- Finance difficulties and debts
- Childcare funding
