If you are receiving any of the following benefits, and are not already receiving free school meals, please apply here [Free school meals - Norfolk County Council](#)

Universal Credit - with an annual earned income of no more than £7,400 after tax

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual gross income of no more than £16,190

Even if you do not wish to use your free school meals, applying still helps raise extra funds for the school (called Pupil Premium). This Government funding helps us support students in and out of the classroom by subsidising the cost of school trips, music lessons, ingredients for food technology, revision guides and many other initiatives.
