Final Exam – Monday 15 June

Leavers' Day – Friday 19 June

Leavers' Day is an optional event, but we hope to see as many students as possible as we celebrate their time at OBHS.

Students should arrive at 11.30am for an assembly and head directly to the Main Hall once they have signed in.

Students are not required to wear school uniform; however, they must wear appropriate casual clothing suitable for a school environment. Jeans, hoodies and similar attire are acceptable. Students who have purchased a Leavers' Hoodie are encouraged to wear it. As it remains a normal school day for all other year groups, any student wearing inappropriate clothing may unfortunately be asked to return home to change.

Following the assembly, celebrations will continue on the field, including opportunities for students to sign shirts and spend time together before moving on to the next stage of their journey.

- A bouncy castle

Students may leave during the afternoon to prepare for Prom if they wish; however, they must sign out at Main Reception before leaving.
