Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

OBHS offers lessons in a range of musical instruments. If you would like to start lessons, please read the information below and complete the attached form. You can return the form to Miss Fox by email or as a paper copy. Your details will then be passed on to the instrumental teacher, who will contact you directly.

Lesson Information

- Students receive one lesson each week during the school day.
- Lessons are either 20 minutes or 30 minutes long.
- Wherever possible, lessons run on a rotating timetable, so students do not miss the same subject every week.

Cost

- £11 for a 20-minute lesson
- £16 for a 30-minute lesson
- Payments are made in advance, in half-term blocks.
- Support may be available for students receiving Pupil Premium or Free School Meals. Please ask if you think this applies to you.

Instruments

Students will need their own instrument. However, the school does have some instruments available to borrow. The instrumental teacher will discuss this with you if needed.
