Whilst attendance has always been central to the business of any school, this unfaltering focus will help reduce any gaps in learning and ensure all students are in the best position possible.

Schools up and down the country are working with stakeholders, families and students to improve their whole school attendance and Old Buckenham High School is no exception. We make no apology for driving for excellent attendance for all our students. A report published by the Department for Education found overall absence had a negative link to attainment, with every extra day missed associated with a lower chance of achieving 5 or more good GCSEs. This will enable them to achieve their potential and ultimately, to leave school with a brace of GCSEs which accurately reflect their capabilities.

Parents and carers play a vital role in supporting their child's attendance, especially in encouraging them to attend when perhaps they're feeling a little under the weather.
