Task 1: Write your name in bold bubble/block lettering.

Decorate your letters using a particular theme. Fill each letter with appropriate mark-making techniques, patterns and colours.



Task 2: Design a pair of boots with street art imagery. You can find boot outlines online to copy from, or if you have access to some boots, draw them using first hand observation.



Task 3: Create a piece of street art that has an ethical or political meaning. Think of issues which mean something to you, such as homelessness, war or the environment. Think about how you could get your message across and how your art might appeal to a younger audience. You can look at

other street artists to get an idea of how this is already being done. Fill at least an A4 page.



Task 4: Design a mural for the local bus shelter which represents Old Buckenham Village in the style of street art. Remember that you will have to consider that some

people might not have the same tastes and may be offended by certain images or the idea of street art. Try to cater for most tastes whilst changing how people may feel about street art.
