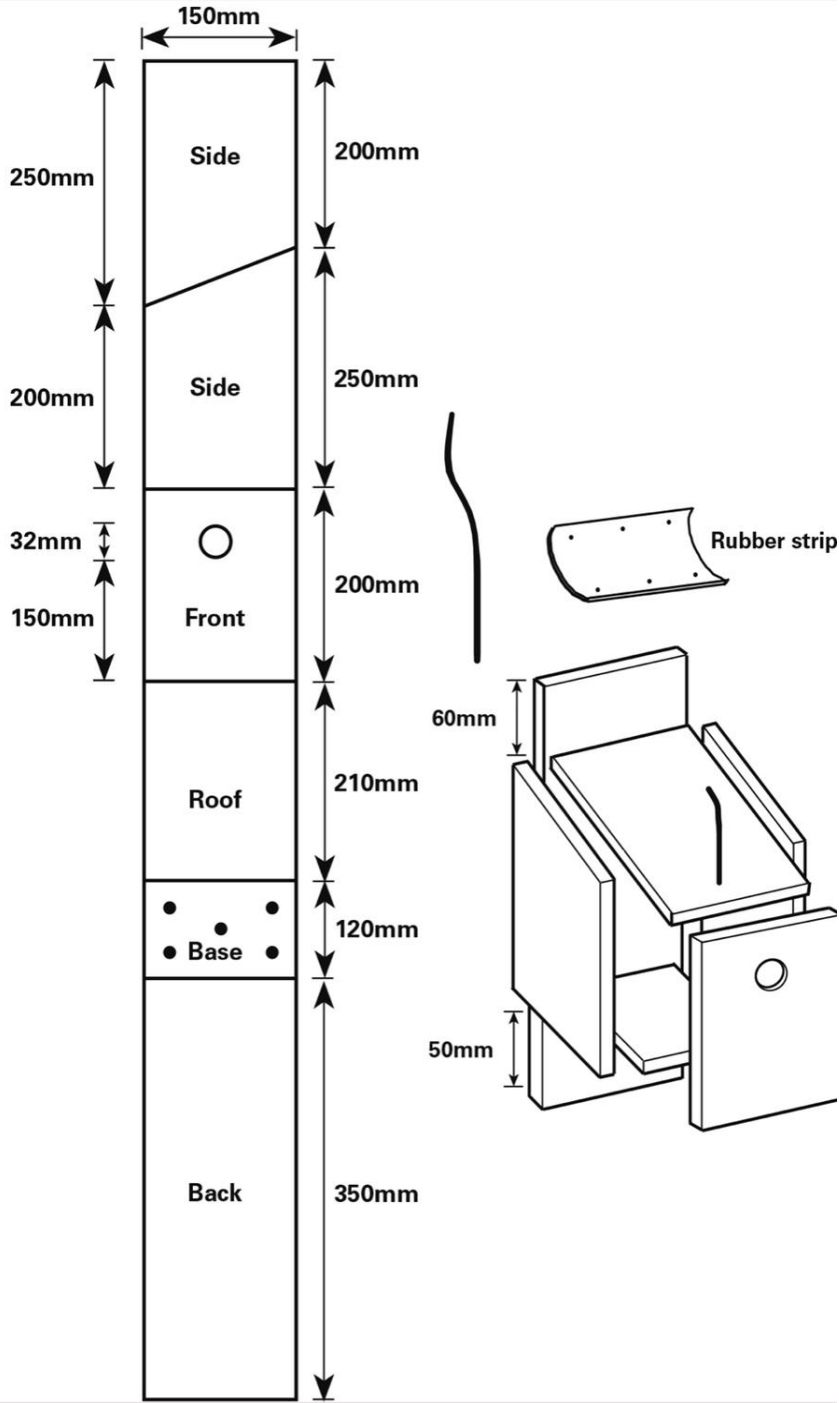


MY BIRDBOX

Drawing out the lines.



The lines are for me to follow so I know what I need to cut.

Cutting the wood.
