Dear Parents and Carers

The Government announced this week that schools can choose to close on Friday 18th December and offer a remote INSET day for staff. If schools make this choice they are asked to make up the teaching time at another point in the academic year.

Old Buckenham High School will **remain open** to all students on Friday 18th December. We feel that it is too late for families to organise childcare, for arrangements to be in place for those entitled for free school meals and for meaningful staff training to be offered. In addition, we have planned our curriculum to include this as a teaching day and would like to complete our units of work as planned.

The key reason behind the Government offer to close early is track and trace. The chart below identifies when the school needs to be contacted if your child has a positive test for coronavirus. If symptoms began up to and including 18th December school needs to be notified to support with contact tracing. Please use my email head@obhs.co.uk to contact the school. After this date families are asked to follow the instructions given by the NHS tack and trace and inform the Sapientia Education Trust (SET) Team on 01953 609001 of any positive cases. The SET phone will be available 10am – 3.15pm across the Christmas period (excluding public holidays and until 1pm on Christmas Eve) if an answer phone message is left please share your child's name, your name, contact number and our school name.
