

YEAR 9 DRAMA HOMEWORK TASKS

Task 1:

Create a glossary of drama terms you have learnt since the start of Year 9. Include a brief description of how they can be used in a performance

Task 3:

Draw and annotate a set design for your most recent performance. You must ensure that the drawing is in full colour, detailed and realistic. Your annotations must explain what you have picked as set and why (its position, its condition, why you have chosen it)

Task 2:

Write a 500 word evaluation of the most recent piece of work you have completed, this could be a one off performance or your assessment piece. What skills did you use in your performance? What do you think you did well? What do you still need to improve on? Be fair to yourself and consider targets to improve on for your next assessment

Task 4:

Create an information booklet that explains the topics you have studied so far in Drama. Explain what you have been working on, include drawings and images of any skills learnt. Include information about Drama lessons, how many you have, how long they are and what you do in them

Task 5:

Pick a performance skill you are not as confident using compared to others. Explain what the skill is, how it can be used in a performance and how you will try and develop this in your next lesson. Consider the pros and cons of using this skill
