Dear Parents and Carers

The half term has flown by and although the weather has been variable at least I have been very pleased with the way our school has run during these challenging times. I have been particularly impressed by the conduct of our students who have followed our procedures and guidelines. However, it is important that we need to maintain our systems particularly as we move into winter. Can you encourage and remind your son/daughter that they need to follow social distancing rules, hand sanitising and the wearing of face coverings, where directed for their safety and the safety of others. We have made some adjustments to our systems and face coverings are compulsory in all corridors and covered areas excluding classrooms where they remain optional.

As we move nearer to the October half term, I wanted to write to you with a request. Naturally a half term week is a time for rest, relaxation and, for many, a holiday abroad. In light of the COVID19 pandemic, please do carefully consider the impact of a trip abroad on your child's education. The Government is currently advising against all but essential international travel. Restrictions and quarantine requirements are often brought in with little notice and any travel out of the UK carries a high risk of the family needing to carry out a 14 day period of self-isolation. To minimise the need for our students to be absent, please do follow the Government guidance concerning travel.
