Dear Parents and Carers

As you know, the Teacher Assessed Grades process is underway and the school is collecting assessment information. Our students have taken the current round of assessments seriously and I am confident that we have a robust process in place that will ensure all of our students receive a grade in each subject that is a reflection of their ability and effort. Additional guidance regarding results day and the process for the collection of exam results will be sent out shortly.

In line with current regulations, covid arrangements are still in place which is making planning for the end of Year 11 difficult. However, following Government and Trust guidance, I can confirm that Year 11 Leavers' Day will be Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June. We are hoping to make sure Leavers' Day follows as closely as we can to the usual day we have for Year 11 to say goodbye to their friends and staff, more details will follow.

With regards to the school Prom, it is more difficult to plan for. The Government's roadmap for removing all covid arrangements will not be finalised until 21<sup>st</sup> June. However, we are keen for our students to have a celebratory event. In discussion with the Trust, staff and students, we are planning for the Prom to take place on the 23<sup>rd</sup> June at school. We hope to hire a marquee, mobile disco and food vendors with the evening starting around 6pm and running until 9pm. More details will follow, but hopefully the evening will be the celebration our Year 11 deserve. We are keen to keep the costs to a minimum. Tickets will be in the region of £15 to £20 and available only to Year 11 students. It would be helpful if you could complete the permission form following the link below by 30<sup>th</sup> April to indicate whether your son/daughter is wishing to attend. I must stress that we will be following all Government guidelines and, in the event of changes to the roadmap, may have to cancel at relatively short notice.
