We want to use smell to spark memories, to tell stories, and to encourage visitors to 'view' the collections in a completely different way.

What will we be doing?

Over October half term you will work with the Museum of Norwich to:


- Research into smells of the past using museum collections and archives

- Help deliver our night time event on Nov 2nd and lead activities, welcome visitors and show off the scents of Norwich's past






























If you have an interest in museums, history or heritage, art or performance, events or marketing and want to gain some valuable experience then this opportunity is for you.
