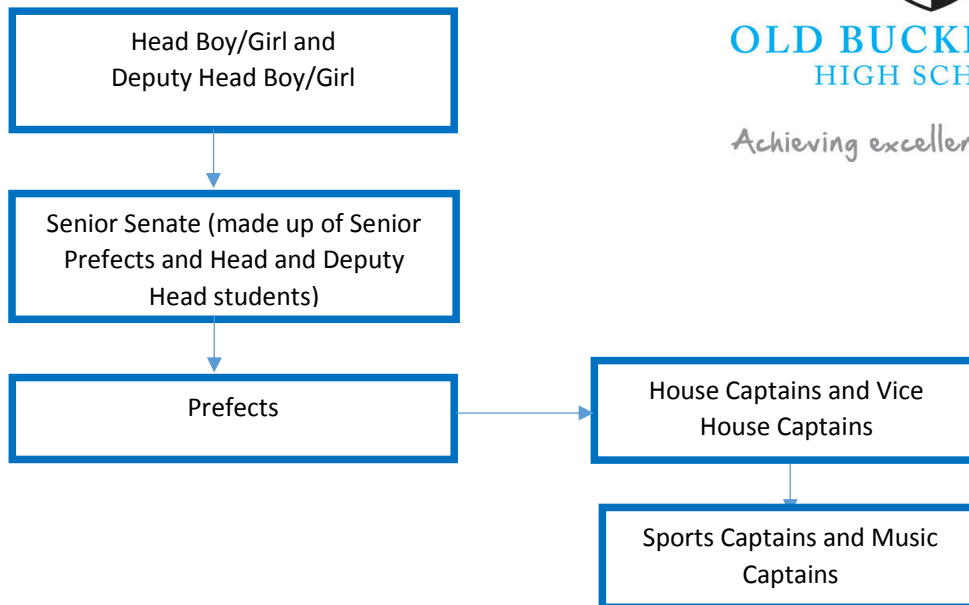

STUDENT LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE



PREFECTS

- These will be appointed in the first part of the Summer Term of Y10. This will initially be a Y10 position which can be carried into Y11
- Maximum of 20% of the year group

Criteria to be considered for appointment

- An average of 2.2 or less over the two most recent tracker reports in Y10
- Making at least expected progress in all but two subjects (unless in exceptional circumstances)
- Referrals to the Progress Centre from no more than two subjects in Y10
- At least 94% attendance in Y10 (unless in exceptional circumstances)
- Take part in at least one school community activity in Y10 (eg. Extra curricular groups)
- Support of the tutor
- Application form
- Interview

Duties

- Break and lunch duties including reporting back to Senior Prefects as to any issues or observations made
- Bus monitoring
- Helping out at Progress Evenings and selected other school events

SENIOR PREFECTS

- These will be appointed in the second half of Y10 taking up post once Y11 begin study leave. This is largely a Y11 position
- Maximum of 10 in any year group

Criteria to be considered for appointment

- Must be a Prefect
- An average of 2 or below over the two most recent tracker reports in Y10
- Making at least expected progress in all but two subjects (unless in exceptional circumstances)
- Referrals to the Progress Centre from no more than one subject in Y10
- Attendance of at least 94% In Y10 (unless in exceptional circumstances)
- Good completion of Prefect duties
- Reference from tutor
- Interview

Duties

- Sit on the Senior Senate
- To chair and support the School Council
- Manage Prefect duty teams including taking reports from duties

There will be a second of Prefect applications in September of Y11 to replace the ones who have been promoted to Senior Prefect. This will be the final round of applications.

HEAD AND DEPUTY BOY AND GIRL

- These will be appointed during the last part of the Summer Term of Y10 to take up role in September of Y11

Criteria for selection

- Must be a Senior Prefect
- Application
- Staff vote and student vote
- Interview

Duties

- Chairing and overseeing Senior Senate
- Overseeing Senior Prefects and House and Vice Captains

The roles of Prefect, Senior Prefect and Head or Deputy Head Boy and Girl can be withdrawn either temporarily or permanently if the criteria fail to be met or as a result of other failure to meet the standards and expectations of the positions.

HOUSE AND VICE HOUSE CAPTAINS

- These will be appointed in the Summer Term of Y10 ready to take up post when Y11 go on study leave

Criteria for Selection

- Voted for by the students in their year groups
- Students who are or wish to be Senior Prefects cannot apply

Duties

- To oversee and co-ordinate House Assemblies
- To oversee and co-ordinate inter house competitions in PE and Music
- To oversee the work of Sports and Music Captains
- To co-ordinate support for tutor groups (eg. Merit point collection)
