I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the issue and collection of your child's summer GCSE examination results. The Year 11 GCSE results will be available for collection from the Main Hall on Thursday 22nd August 2019 between 10am and 12pm. It is important to inform you that only the students themselves are able to collect their GCSE results I would also like to make you aware that GCSE results cannot be sent by email or communicated over the phone to students or parents. Any GCSE results that are not collected in person on the results day itself will be posted out to students at their home address. If they would like to nominate another person to collect their results they will need to inform the school examinations officer, Mrs Skipsey, in writing or by email (exams@obhs.co.uk) before the end of term on Wednesday 24th July 2019.

Students will also be able to view their results in Go4Schools from 10am on Thursday 22nd August 2019.

During results day the school senior leadership team will be on hand to support and answer any questions you or your child may have from 10 am until 3pm. We fully appreciate that this morning can be an anxious and nervous time for students and their families and therefore will be making the morning a calm and low-key event in the Hall.
