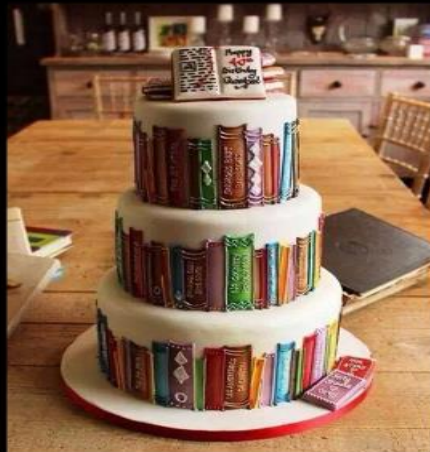
## Which staff member is reading what?
