We were delighted to hear how happy your children are to be back in school following two years of disturbed education, it was also excellent to hear that you feel well informed and communicated with. We have passed on to staff some of the positive comments that were made, as it is lovely for them to hear that their hard work is being well received. It's clear from the positive points logged on Go4Schools that your children have returned to school with a great Attitude to their Learning as when we have a positive residual of 6410 positive points (when subtracting any negative points awarded) from the Autumn Term so far.

We will be holding our Parents Forum online on the 22<sup>nd</sup> November where we will discuss further some of the topics and themes which arose from this parent voice survey. We will send out the invite and agenda to all parents the week before and welcome you all to come and share your views to work with us on continuing to improve our school and the OBHS community.
