## **Student Homework**

Over this term, we have been working on developing a bank of homework resources which can be used by all students to support their learning. Some content-heavy subjects have produced knowledge maps for students to ensure that the important information is clearly laid out for students to learn, other subjects have approached the task by designing a series of tasks linked to the knowledge and skills important for students to make progress in that area.

While students should be set homework on Go4Schools, staff and student absence can sometimes mean that homeworks are missed. The resources saved on the website can be used in addition to/alongside any homework set by the classroom teacher and aim to either consolidate their learning, or practise applying their knowledge or skills in new contexts.

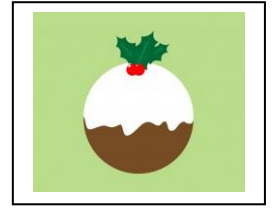
