Careers from Geography



Geologist

How do I get into it?

- Study geography at GCSE, A Level and either geography, earth science or geology at University.
- You can also do a master degree to specialise in different areas.

What does this job entail?

- Geologists are responsible for identifying & assessing the location, quantity & quality of mineral deposits/rocks. Their work can be office based, although fieldwork is necessary to collect and test site/ borehole samples.
- A great job for people who love getting their hands dirty, Discovering the earth's history and a more scientific type of work.

What will I earn?

- Average salaries for starting jobs in geology are around £25,000 to £30,000 in the UK. These can go up to 6 figure salaries when you get to senior levels of the work.
