Message from the Headteacher

Last week we saw quite significant disruptions to attendance of staff and students in part due to the national shortage of testing for Covid. However, I have been very pleased with the continued way our students have been adapting to the changes we have made and how cooperative they have been. This has been due to the positive attitude our students are displaying and the enormous hard work of our staff. Students have been complying with our expectations around face coverings, could I ask parents to remind students that they need to follow the guidelines around safe removal and the face coverings should be stored in a plastic bag in a pocket when not being worn.

School Food Service

We are hoping to restart a limited food service on Monday. Cold snacks and drinks will be available from the 3 zones using our cashless system at break time and Lunch.

Remote Learning

Plans are fully in place if the school has to partially close, which we very much wish to avoid. It is very important that parents fully understand our GoforSchools online platform and are able to log on. If you are unable to do so or do not have access to an internet enabled device at home please contact the school as soon as possible.

School Transport

It is parent's responsibility to ensure their child has a suitable face covering for school transport and that a student may be denied access to school transport in the morning if they do not have one. Your child's safety and welfare remain your responsibility until they have safely boarded school transport. In addition, can you remind your child that if they do not sit in their allocated seat or they remove their face covering during transit the bus placement may be suspended or removed.
