## Events Managers

organise and run promotional, business, cultural and social events.

## Skills

### Day to day tasks:

- Discuss what type of event the client wants
- Devise original ideas for events
- Agree budgets and timescales with the client
- Book venues, entertainment, equipment and supplies
- Hire and supervise contractors like caterers and security
- Publicise events
- Follow health, safety and insurance regulations
- Ensure everything runs smoothly on the day

## Subjects

English, Mathematics, Enterprise and Marketing.

## Routes into the industry

- A **university course** in Events Management, Marketing or Communication
- A **college course** such as a BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma in Production Arts & Live Events
- An **advanced apprenticeship** as an events assistant
- **Volunteering** or **applying directly**

## Salary\*

Starting at £17,000 and up to £80,000 for an experienced events manager.

## Jobs

This sector is projected to grow by 6.3% by 2027, creating 4,700 jobs.

\*In 2020 the average salary was £31,461, up 3.6% on 2019.

Annual pay estimates are largely unaffected by Covid-19.
