- Consequences of unprotected sex. This will include STI's and pregnancy and the options available including abortion.

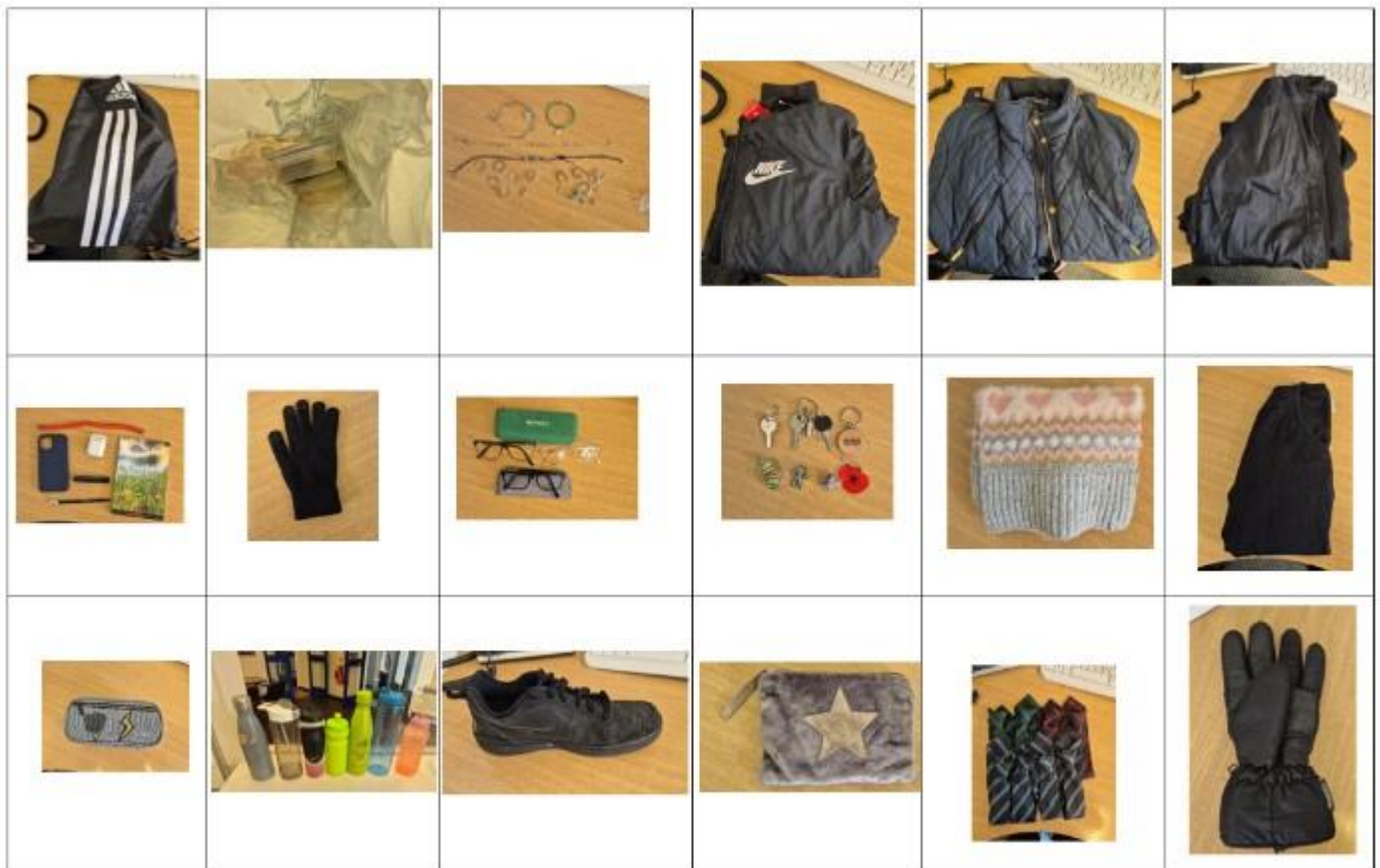
We have an obligation as a school to ensure that this statutory information is relayed to students in a safe environment and allow them the opportunity to ask questions.
