Equipment	Teachers will not be allowed to lend students stationery. This means that you need to make sure you bring all of the equipment on the equipment checklist to school every day. The checklist is included on the uniform policy. You must also make sure that you have a big enough bag to carry your A4 laminated card pack which we will provide you with.					
Attendance	The government have said that it is compulsory for all students to attend school full time from September. This means that if you are absent, it will be recorded in the usual way. Remember that it is important to keep your attendance above 95%.					
Behaviour	 There have been a few small changes to the behaviour policy. To summarise: The number of warnings before a lesson removal has been reduced from 2 warnings to 1. Any behaviour which increases the risk of contamination will be classified as C4 (serious) incident and dealt with accordingly. Examples of behaviour which would fall into this category are spitting, close physical contact (e.g fighting or 'play fighting'), deliberate actions which could transfer the disease (hand to mouth contact, for example). Any student using language relating to COVID which might cause others to feel worried, anxious or victimised (accusing somebody of having it, or telling others that you or somebody else has it, for example) will be considered a serious (C4) incident. Incorrect uniform, lesson removal, failure to complete another sanction will result in a lunchtime detention with the Senior Leadership Team. 					
Food and drink						
Staying Safe	 There will be hand sanitising stations in every classroom. Use these regularly to sanitise your hands, and wash your hands thoroughly under running water and with soap any time you use the toilet. Follow the one-way system during lesson changeover. Keep your distance: when talking to your friends at social times, keep a little distance between you; when walking between lessons, leave a gap between you and the person in front. 					
School Clubs	Unfortunately, we will not be able to run our usual timetable of extra-curricular activities as we would be unable to maintain our Year group 'bubbles' if we did so. If the guidance changes throughout the year and we are able to start running clubs, you will be the first to know!
