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Tutor Groups

- ▶ At OBHS we will have five Tutor Groups in Year 7. Each child will be placed in to one of our Houses.
- ▶ To aid this process, each child will complete a Friendship Request Form and we will ensure that your child will be placed with one of their friends listed.
- ▶ Students will not necessarily be allocated to the same house (Blue, Green, Purple, Red or Yellow) as their siblings. □
- ▶ Tutor Groups are set up in liaison with the Year 7 Head of Year, Pastoral Manager and the SENDCo. We also take into consideration recommendations from your child's Year 6 primary teachers.
- ▶ We aim to provide a balance of gender and a good spread of attainment levels in each group, as well as taking into account personal and social factors.

- ▶ Our uniform is smart and practical. Correct uniform should be worn at all times.
- ▶ Black trousers can be worn by girls and boys but must be of the style seen on the website of Birds of Dereham
- ▶ Girls should wear one of the 'OBHS' skirts as supplied by Birds of Dereham
- ▶ A white shirt and correct House coloured tie.
- ▶ Blazers should have the appropriately coloured school logo on and should be brought into school at all times.
- ▶ Shoes must be black and not 'trainer style'.
- ▶ No makeup & only one pair of stud earrings are allowed.
- ▶ Full and correct OBHS PE kit must be worn for PE lessons - note from home always required if a student is to be excused from taking part.
- ▶ You will receive a full uniform specification in your student pack
