

# Year 8 History Homework Summer Term Challenge

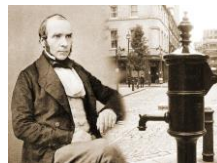


Each gold activity will take at least 1 hour to complete

Create a 'Horrible Histories' song about the workhouses. You can watch the one on Victorian work ('Work, Terrible Work') for inspiration. You can even record it if you wish.



Each silver activity will take at least 30 minutes to complete

Create a cartoon strip for a day in the life of a climbing boy (chimney sweep).



Create a tourist information leaflet for a workhouse of your choice e.g. Gressenhall.



Research Elizabeth Fry and create a fact file on her for our 'Norfolk Heroes Hall of Fame'. Include who she was, what she did and why she was significant.



Each bronze activity will take at least 20 minutes to complete

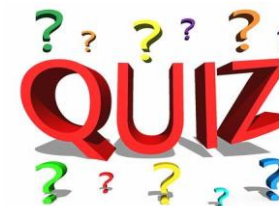
Design a poster for or against political reform in the 1830s.
