It is expected that all work is attempted, all set videos are watched, and that students contact their teacher via email if they get stuck.	Feedback is given instantly by Hegarty Maths. Students should re-watch the videos if they got the answers wrong. Students should leave queries as feedback on any question in order to receive personal feedback and guidance from their teacher.

Students will receive feedback through Teams within 48 hours of submission. Certain assignments have been chosen for personalised feedback. This is highlighted in the assignment. These assignments will occur at a minimum once every 2 weeks.
		Students working offline: The offline tracker sets out work each lesson (following the previous timetable). The tracker document and this half terms resources can also be accessed on the school website under summer 2 home learning.	Off-line assignments mirror the online tasks, with differentiated resources. Paper based packs that cover the whole of next term will be sent out to students who have requested them at the start of the half term.	Students should email in pictures of work or drop work off to Reception for teacher marking regularly (minimum of once/fortnight).	Student must submit work once a fortnight to their class teacher(s). Depending on how work has been submitted class teachers will provide personalised feedback a minimum once every two weeks. Please note that due to differences in teachers accessing the school site, there may be a delay in return of work handed to Reception.
