### Your Brief

To design a wildlife house to go in a garden. It could be a bird house, bird feeder or bee house. It could hang from a tree or be drilled to a wall.

### Your tasks

#### Task 1—Moodboard

Pick a designer you are inspired by. Create a mood board of their work.

#### Task 2—Initial Ideas

Using the images from your moodboard draw 4 initial ideas (on A4 paper) for your wildlife house.

#### Task 3—Final Design or Model

Chose between either drawing your final design or making a model of it.

**Final Design**—on A3 draw and colour your final design. You need to include annotations that describe it, say how it could be made, the dimensions and give an opinion on why it meets the brief.

#### Or

**Model making**—using any materials that you can find (cereal boxes, plastic bottles, papier-mâché) make a model of your design. Its foot print should be no bigger in size than your planner opened up.

#### Task 4—Evaluation

Evaluate the success of your product and suggest how it could be improved. You could ask others for their opinions.
